



Aftercare Instructions for Red Vein Treatment

- Do - apply antiseptic cream to treated area 3 times in the 24 hours following your treatment.
- Do - bathe the area with a cold solution of salt water regularly during the 24 hours following treatment, this reduces inflammation and speeds up the healing process. (Add half a teaspoon of salt to one cup of boiling water and chill, because the skin gets hot if you remove the heat it will begin the healing process faster).
- Do - wear sun block over the area for 4 weeks after treatment, (sunlight interferes with the natural healing process).
- Do Not - touch the area with your fingers.
- Do Not - pick any crusts that may appear. These may form as part of the healing process.
- Do Not - expose the area to Sun, Sunlight or Sunbeds for 4 weeks after treatment, this interferes with the natural healing process.
- Do Not - wear make up over the area if any crusts are formed.
- Do Not - use any toning lotions over the area for 10 days.
- Use very gentle cleanser and be careful not to remove any crusts that may appear.
- Do Not - use glycolic or other AHA's over the area for 2 weeks.
