

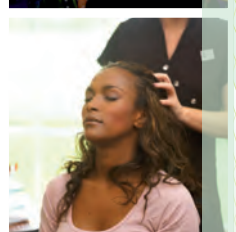
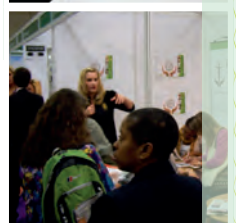

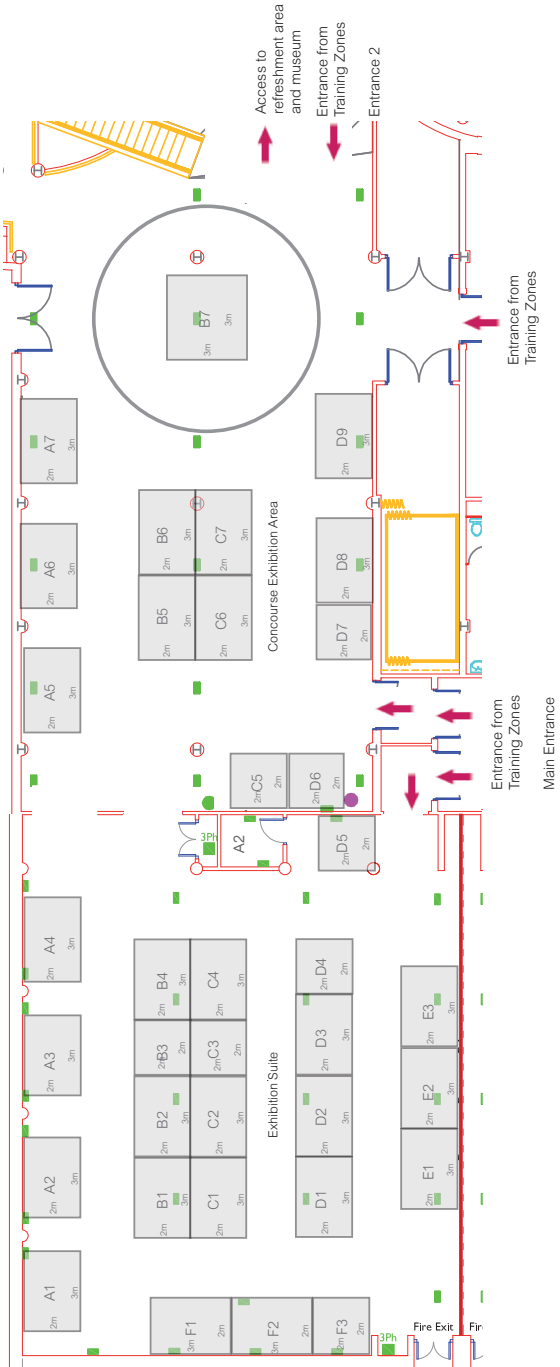
## Celebrating a special occasion
