

Meeting of the FHT Governing Council held on 2nd May 2013

Summary of FHT Register Minutes

- The FHT submitted its application to have its Register accredited by the Professional Standards Authority AVR Scheme on 20th June 2013.
- The FHT is advertising for the recruitment of lay representatives on the FHT Governing Council to ensure that there is governance input from service users. The Council were informed that an application has been received and will be reviewed for consideration for interview.
- A review of the Register metrics was held.
- A review of the Registrants' Complaints was held.
- A review of applications received from therapists holding unspent convictions was held. Both applications were refused following review and agreement that they posed a risk to the public and service users.
- An update on the review of the FHT Code of Conduct & Professional Practice was given and the Council was informed that the revised Code is expected to go out to member and public consultation in October 2013.
- There were no new complementary therapy applications received in the Quarter.
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- A review of public and service user feedback was conducted by the Council. All feedback was positive and complimentary of the FHT member.
- The FHT Risk Registers were reviewed by the Council and one amendment was made and recorded. No recommendations for additional risks were identified by the Council and the Risk Registers were approved and signed as satisfactory.
- The FHT Registrar reported that there were no updates on the Register management to be reported.
- The Council was informed that the CPD audit for registrants conducted during Q1 were all accepted as meeting the register standard
- There was no other matters to be discussed.
- It was agreed that the next meeting of the FHT Governing Council will take place on 25th July 2013.

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
