Thank you for enquiring about course accreditation with the Federation of Holistic Therapists (FHT), the leading professional association representing complementary, beauty and sports therapists in the UK and Ireland.

Accompanying this letter is an information pack with everything you need to know about obtaining FHT accreditation.

The FHT maps courses to the National Occupational Standards (NOS) and Core Curricula, where available. Where there are none, the therapy is considered by both the FHT and our insurance underwriter, Hiscox Ltd., to ensure that FHT members are able to obtain insurance to practise the therapy once qualified.

Please note that FHT accredits the course, not the training centre or its tutors.

Following successful accreditation, you will:

- receive an FHT Accreditation certificate which is valid for 12 months from the date of issue
- be entitled to use the FHT Accreditation logo on your certificates and advertising material for the duration of your accreditation
- be eligible to have your course(s) listed in the FHT Course Listings scheme for a competitive price
- have a free basic listing on the FHT Accredited course providers area of the FHT website
- have a free basic listing on the FHT Accredited course provider pages in the FHT's membership magazine, International Therapist.

To apply for accreditation, please ensure that you:

1. Carefully read the FHT Accreditation Terms and Conditions and guidance information on the application forms
2. Complete the application forms and submit these together with the application fee of £25 plus VAT per course. Your application will not be processed without payment.
3. Ensure all relevant supporting documents and accreditation fees are submitted in a timely manner following the completion of the application process. **Please refer to the accompanying price structure.**
